As a military spouse, Mrs. Brewer supports her active duty husband, Second Lieutenant Steven Brewer of the U.S. Army, who is nearing the end of a half year long rehab thousands of miles away for injuries sustained in a military training accident.

At home, Chelle continues to care for their two children, including three-year old daughter, Lorelei, who was born with a severe heart defect. Mrs. Brewer has triumphed over adversity, while continuing to find time to volunteer. She volunteers for many organizations, including the USO, American Red Cross, American Heart Association, Ronald McDonald House, and March of Dimes.

Additionally, her commitment to our troops led to the creation of Soldier’s List organization in 2002 that has sent over 4,000 care packages to deployed soldiers, raised funds to support schools in Iraq and Afghanistan, and created Veteran’s Day programs paying tribute to all who serve. Both President and First Lady Laura Bush sent letters of recognition of service for Soldier’s List efforts.
